The United States EB-5 Program

The EB-5 Immigration Investor Program is an extremely successful program as it creates the opportunity for investors and their families to obtain a U.S. Permanent Residency (a "Green Card") by investing in American businesses that create new jobs. It was originally created by the U.S. Congress in 1990 and has recently been updated in 2022, becoming even more attractive to potential investors.

Overview of applicant requirements

- Must not be a U.S. Person*
- Must be an accredited investor
- Make an eligible commercial investment which complies with the program investment criteria
- Must be able to prove that the funds invested were derived from lawful sources

* As defined by the Securities Act of 1933, this can be found in Section 902(k)(1)

Who is eligible to apply under the same application as the main investor?

- Spouse or legal partner
- Unmarried children under the age of 21 years old

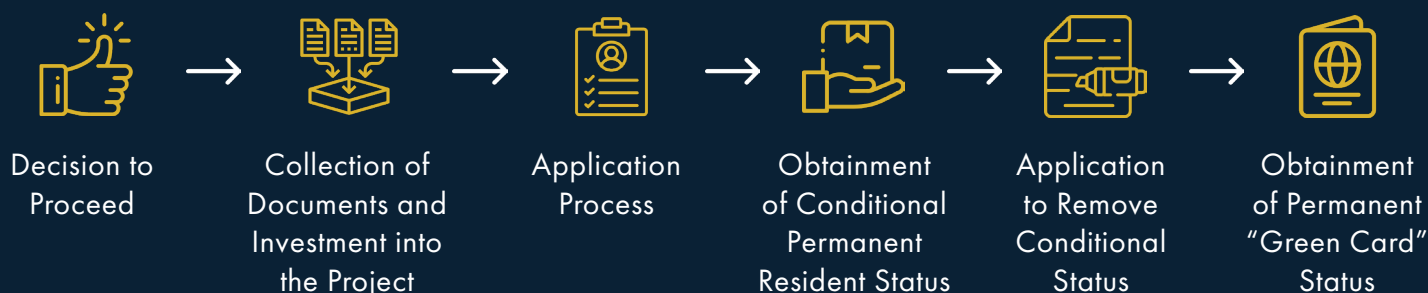

Investment Criteria:

The standard minimum EB-5 investment is \$1,050,000 which is reduced to \$800,000 if the investment is in a designated targeted employment area (TEA)*

Other Criteria for the investment to be eligible are:

- The investment must create at least 10 permanent, full-time jobs for qualified U.S. workers in a period of two years
- The investment must be considered "at-risk" i.e. the investor cannot receive any guarantees or contractual rights for repayment.

Investors have the opportunity to invest via two options, either through a Regional Center or through a direct investment. The Regional Center is by far the most popular option as an investor does not have the hassle of managing the day-to-day activities of the business and there is more flexibility for job creation.

*A TEA is defined as a rural area or an area that has experienced high unemployment of at least 150% of the national average
